## Policy Statement

The Auraria Campus requires that pet owners are responsible for the behavior of their pets. The campus encourages responsible and courteous ownership and has set forth the following guidelines for owners:

- Animals shall not be disruptive (e.g., barking)
- Animals shall be restrained and under control at all times (e.g., actively restrained on a leash, not passively by voice command)
- The owner or handler shall properly dispose of all animal waste
- The owner is responsible for all damages and injuries caused by the animal
- This policy in no way restricts the use of service animals

The individual campus institutions may adopt their own policies for pets within their institutionally owned buildings or assigned internal spaces.
